Group KAP for Queer Folx provides ketamine-assisted psychotherapy exclusively for LGBTQIA+ people, in an affirming, identity-centered space. With preparation, guided sessions, and integration support, participants heal and grow alongside a supportive community.

- Group Prep: December 11 — 7:30pm - 9:00pm (in-person)
- Ketamine Event: December 13 — 12:00pm - 5:00pm (in-person)
- Integration: December 15 — 7:30pm - 9:00pm (Zoom)

Cost: The base cost of the program is \$750 (intake sessions, the ketamine day, and integration). We offer a sliding scale of \$450–\$1,125, based on your income bracket. We are committed to making this accessible.
